

Introducing Stream

A New Class of Aircraft Reinventing the Magic of Flight

Manufactured in Europe by TL Sport Aircraft and distributed/supported by TL North America based in Charleston, SC, the Stream is a tandem-seat/side-stick controlled, high-performance aircraft featuring an all carbon composite airframe, Kevlar/Carbon cockpit, aircraft ballistic parachute system, on-board oxygen, and a Garmin glass cockpit.

New factory-built Streams are designated "Light-Sport Category Aircraft" per MOSAIC rules, which become effective in July 2026, but buyers also have the option to coordinate a factory build towards an "Experimental-Amateur Built" (E-AB) designation if preferred.

The TL Sport Aircraft factory, located in the Czech Republic, has been designing/building market-leading, light sport aircraft for over 35 years, including the Sting, Sirius and Sparker. The Stream has been flying in Europe for over 10 years.

At its core, the Stream represents the height of design, styling and comfort, but it's also packed with plenty of adrenaline and thrills! It looks, feels and handles like a military fighter, but its true mission is the magic of pilot-plane partnership and the cherished adventure of flight!

The Stream is modestly priced given its superior design and capability, with factory pricing beginning at \$358,000 pending buyer preferences. Garmin G3X and GFC 500 are standard equipment on all aircraft. 30% purchase price due at factory order, with progressive deposits through production (typically 7-9 months from order to delivery). Factory warranty is 2 years or 100 hours, and transition training/check-out included for one pilot at the Summerville Airport (KDYB) in South Carolina. Leasing options also available.
